


Fitting Instructions Compact Ironing Centre


These instructions are for your safety. Please read through them before fitting the product & retain for future reference. Failure to follow them could cause injury and/or property damage.

This appliance is not intended for use by persons including children with reduced physical, sensory, mental capabilities, or lack of experience/knowledge; unless supervision or instruction concerning the use of this appliance has been given by the person(s) responsible for their safety.
Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.


- This product must be fitted by qualified personnel only.
- Ensure the wall is suitable to take the weight and loading of the product whilst it is in use.
- Ensure there are no electrical, gas or water fittings in the wall.
- The supplied fixings are suitable for most types of solid wall; however it is the responsibility of the fitter to ensure they are appropriate.



1. Hold the ironing board in the desired position. Make sure it is level using a spirit level. Mark the positions (A) on the wall. Drill holes at the marked positions suitable for the fixings used. Re-align the ironing board and fix in place using an electric screw driver (recommended).



2. Once the main body is in place, hold the head section flush to the top of the ironing board and mark the positions (B) on the wall. Drill holes at the marked positions suitable for the fixings used. Re-align the head section and fix in place using an electric screw driver (recommended).



3. Fix the mains lead along the side of the back board at points (C) using the clips provided.

Locate the iron, rear first, into the cradle (as shown).
